Educating children to behave safely

HANDS ON play & learn ball

- Recognising safe/unsafe situations
- Talking about safety rules when crossing the road, cycling, riding in cars and buses, etc.
- Learning about traffic lights and what each colour indicates
- Discussing cycle helmet, reflective vest, child car seat, etc.
- Right/left recognition
- Learning the Crossing Code: Stop, look and listen
- Kerb training, zebra crossing/pedestrian pavement rules
- Enhancing oral language skills and narrative capacity
